CBSE NATIONAL ROPE SKIPPING CHAMPIONSHIP 2023-24 Under 14 & 19 years (Boys & Girls) 17th, 18th, 19th & 20th Nov. 2023

Rules and Regulations

GENERAL INFORMATION:

CBSE National Rope Skipping Championship 2023-24 (under 14 & 19 years for Boys & Girls) will be held from 17th Nov. to 20th Nov. 2023 at RAJIV GANDHI INTERNATIONAL SR. SEC. SCHOOL, DABHADI, TAL. MALEGAON, (NASHIK)

The school is located 42 kms. away from Manmad railway station and 05 kms from Malegaon Bus Stand. Conveyance will be arranged for outstation participating schools from railway station/bus stand to our school campus on prior information and request.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

17-11-2023 (Friday)	:Arrival & Reporting of the outstation participating teams.
17-11-2023 (Friday 7:30 pm)	:Meeting of participating team Manager/Coach, CBSE Observer & the Management Committee.
18-11-2023 (Saturday)	:Opening Ceremony & Day 1 Events.
19-11-2023 (Sunday)	:Day 2 Events.
20-11-2023 (Monday)	:Day 3 Events, Closing Ceremony and Dispersal of Teams.

CHAMPIONSHIP RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. The Championship will be played as per the CBSE inter school sports & games competitions organizational rules.
2. The judgment(s) /decision(s) of the CBSE Observer / panel of judges will be final and binding.
3. No school shall be permitted to participate unless they fill the online entry proforma and by hand entry proforma shall not be accepted.
4. Each school is entitled to send only one team for each category consisting of only bonafide students of the concerned school who have been on the rolls from the beginning of the academic year shall be eligible to play in the Championship subject to the given age criteria as per CBSE:

Age category	Born on or after
U-14 years	01-01-2010
U-19 years	01-01-2005

5. A student, who has failed twice in a particular class shall not be eligible to participate in the championship.

6. **Each participating team will submit the following documents to the Organizing Head in the meeting of Coaches and Managers on 17th Nov, 2023 at 7:30 pm.**
 - i) **Attested photocopy of Birth certificate issued by State Government duly attested by Head of the Institution/Gazetted officer.**
 - ii) **The team photo with Principal and photograph of Coach/Manager in the given format duly attested by Principal.**
 - iii) **Online participant' sentry proforma.**
 - iv) **Eligibility performa filled online counter signed by the Principal with school seal.**
 - v) **CBSE registration number for the students studying class X and above.**
 - vi) **To provide original documents for verification (If asked for).**

7. Each participating school will bring two school flags, one for the hoisting and the other for the march past which they will hand over to the Organizing Head on arrival or meeting of coaches and managers and will be returned after the championship.

8. Participation in march past is compulsory, failing which their right to participate can be forfeited.

9. **Time and venue of the events can be subject to change to suit the prevailing conditions. In case of any such changes teams will be notified accordingly.**

10. **Teams should report to the venue 30 minutes prior to the event. If any team fails to report in time to start the event shall not be entertained detail.**

11. The judges for each event shall be appointed by the Organizing Committee. No objection shall be entertained against such appointment.

12. Protest if any, will be submitted with documentary proof to the Organizing Head in prescribed proforma within 30 minutes after the event is over with a protest fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) in cash (refundable if the protest is upheld).The decision of the Jury of Appeal will be Final.

STRUCTURE OF JURY OF APPEAL:

1. Principal 2. Organizing Head 3. CBSE Observer 4. One/Two Technically Qualified Persons
- Organizing school in no case will show the details of player to any one who lodge the protest. Only Jury of Appeal will have the right to verify the entire document.
13. Note am will be allowed to participate with out the Team Manager/Coach designated by the School Principal. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials Any non-designated person(s) accompanying the team will not be entertained nor allowed to stay at the venue.

 14. Incase of girl participants, one of the accompanied official must be female.

 15. **Any violation in the eligibility, over aged etc. shall be dealt with according to the rules.**

DISCIPLINE

1. All the participants of the team and their in-charges will be under the administrative control of the Principal and the Organizing Secretary of the organizing school. They will be governed by the rules and regulations of the school / CBSE.
2. In discipline on part of any team or its members will lead to disqualification and team /member may be debarred from the event/championship and will be asked to leave the campus immediately. Team Manager shall be responsible for the conduct of the team on the ground and the school campus.
3. Each participant and official accompanied must carry their school I-card at the time of registration which they will be carrying during their stay in the campus throughout the championship. Participants/officials may be asked to produce the I-card by any Security or Staff on Duty, failing which the candidate will not be allowed to enter the campus.
4. **Participants should not bring cell phones camera. Jewelry or any other expensive items/gadgets in the campus during the championship.**
5. **Out station participants will keep all their belongings in their designated rooms under lock and key. In no case participants will use their mobile phone in campus during event.**
6. **If any participant found using mobile phones in the campus during event hour. the phone will be seized and strict action will be taken against such participants which may lead up to debarred from one event to entire championship.**
7. **Consumption of liquor, tobacco, cigarette, biri, gutkha, panmasala or any other form of drugs are strictly prohibited in the school campus and is a punishable offence. Any such activity on the part of any team will lead to its disqualification from the championship and the team may be asked to leave the campus immediately.**
8. The players, coaches and managers are expected to strictly adhere to the Rules and Regulations and Spirit of Sportsmanship and maintain a healthy sporting atmosphere during the championship. Any unfair and unwarranted behavior from anyone concerned may invite suspension from the championship.
9. **All the Participating Schools will submit Security Deposit of Rs. 2000.00 on reporting which will be refunded while departure.** Any damage to the school property by the participants or official accompanied may be compensated from the security deposit on the actual basis.
10. **Local teams are not allowed to go inside the hostel premises and areas "Out of Bound".**

ARRIVAL AND RECEPTION

All the outstation participating teams must reach the school campus by **3 p.m. on 17th Nov. 2023 (Friday)**. They must also intimate to the school about their journey details in the format given on school website latest by **09th October 2023**.

ACCOMMODATION & FOOD:

- 1) All outstation teams will be provided campus accommodation, separately for boys and girls. Essential bedding will be provided if intimated in advance.
- 2) Outstation teams will bring lock with two keys to lock their allotted rooms. One key to be submitted to the Organizing Secretary after reporting which will be used by cleaning staff and in emergency.
- 3) Team coaches, managers and participants shall be provided meals as per school mess menu at a nominal charge of **Rs 500/-** per head, per day including bedding charges. Meals/snacks would be served as per the scheduled mess timings only. Team Manager should purchase food coupon(s) from the 'Registration Counter' in advance.
- 4) If the championship is conducted on knock out basis, the participating schools will collect food coupons on full day basis and no part payment will be accepted and participating school will not insist for refund part of payment.
- 5) School will operate tuck shop where students can buy water bottles, juices and other eatables in cash.


1. SR SPEED AND DOUBL EUNDER RELAY 30 SECOND SX4 SKIPPERS= 120 SECONDS
(2 SKIPPERS FOR SPEED & 2 FOR DOUBLE UNDER)
2. DOUBL EDUTCH SPEED RELAY 45 SECOND SX 4 SKIPPERS = 180 SECONDS
3. SINGLE ROPE PAIR FREE STYLE 60 - 75 SECONDS (2 SKIPPERS)
4. SINGLE ROPE TEAM FREE STYLE 60 -75 SECONDS (4 SKIPPERS)
5. DOUBL EDUT CHSING LE FREESTYLE 60 – 75 SECONDS (3 SKIPPERS)
6. DOUBL EDUT CHPAIR FREE STYLE 60 – 75 SECONDS (4 SKIPPERS)
7. DOUBL EDUT CHPAIR SPEED 60 SEC. (EACH) X 2 SKIPPERS (2 TURNER) = 4 SKIPPER

RULES

1. *The championship will be held directly at National level.*
2. The championship will be held under 14 & 19 years age category.
3. Separate championship will be held for Boys & Girls category.
4. A team shall consist of maximum four player sin each category.
5. In each age group, entries from total 25 Boys Team/Schools and 25 Girls Team/Schools will be accepted on first cum first basis.
6. In case of an injury during the competition, the skipper or his/her coach will decide whether to continue the event or not. There will be no re-skip and the event will be scored based on what was shown.
7. Broken Rope or Handle: If a rope or a handle breaks, a repeat attempt is permitted after a suitable rest period of at least 10 minutes. How ever, a team or skipper may only have a maximum of two attempts for the same event. The last attempt determines the score.
